- You have 25 minutes to complete the test.
- You may have up to 3 attempts within the 25 minutes
- Your test result will be displayed immediately on the screen at the end of the test
- You must achieve at least 80 out of 100 to pass this test
- 1. Login in AIS Moodle with your personal ESS account via <u>https://moodle.ais.ac.nz</u>
- 2. Click on My courses
